There has always been an Italian way and then the other way. For an Italian immigrant in America in the 1950s the community was self-sufficient. There was a bread man, a coal man, an ice man, a fruit and vegetable man that serviced the neighborhoods. It wasn't about going to the store it was about the goods coming to you.

The wine program at Formento's is based on that same ideal of personal service. We want our wine stewards and sommeliers to be your wine men and women, helping you make your way through the over 500 selections available to a wine that is right for you and at the right price. We highlight the story of Italy coming to America in two instances.

First, a modern tale of George Vare who took cuttings of Ribolla Gialla from Josko Gravner in Friuli and planted them into his own vineyard in Oak Knoll, Napa Valley in 1999.

A man, who at one point revolutionized wine making by bringing bag in the box to America, was now bringing a varietal across the shores for the first time. Vare translated it through the sunshine and volcanic soils of Napa Valley into an American wine with an Italian soul. Along his journey with this grape he inspired young producers who would change the landscape of wine in California.

Second, a story of the historical vineyards of California planted by Italian, German, and Portuguese immigrants pre and post prohibition. These vineyards were co-planted with not only Zinfandel, which has co-opted the term old vines, but Carignan, Alicante Bouchet, Grenache, Mourvedre, Syrah, Petite Sirah, Grand Noir, Tannat, Trousseau, Valdiguie, French Colombard and many more. These field blends are some of the most historically important, ageable, and underappreciated wines in all of California.

The list ends with a selection of 50+ wines for \$50 and under and then traverses through the classic winemaking regions with a focus on Italy, America and France.

We hope you enjoy the abbondanza of our wine list. Through wine, food, service and most of all hospitality, we are here to assist in making your night memorable.

# FARMING METHODS

At Formento's we are choosing to call attention to sustainable, organic and biodynamically farmed wines placing symbols next to wines which use these methods.



## SUSTAINABLE

Sustainable farming utilizes techniques that minimize negative impacts on the environment and the community while maintaining economic viability and a balanced and diversified ecosystem. By reducing the use of chemicals and energy used to farm grapes, sustainable farmers help ensure a vineyard's ecological well-being as well as the current and future health of society as a whole.



## ORGANIC

Organic grape growing is a practice that does not employ the use of man-made fertilizers, pesticides or anything that has been genetically modified. The primary focus of an organic viticulturist is to promote the health of the soil through the use of organic fertilizers or composts. By feeding the soil rather than just the vines there becomes a natural development of living organisms, which promotes plant health and decreases the likelihood of disease.

Organic certification standards are set by a government agency and vary by country. While many practicing organic producers are certified, some may practice organic farming but choose not to be certified.



## BIODYNAMIC

Biodynamic viticulture is an enhanced form of organic farming which considers a vineyard is part of a living, ecological whole that is co-dependent on the soil, plants and animals of an area. Biodynamic farming techniques include applying prepared organic composts to the soil while following the rhythm of lunar and cosmic cycles or harvesting to the phases of the moon or positions of the planets. These practices are thought to enhance the life of the soil and help maintain balance within a self-sustaining environment. This holistic approach to viticulture believes that wine becomes a true expression of the site in which it is grown.

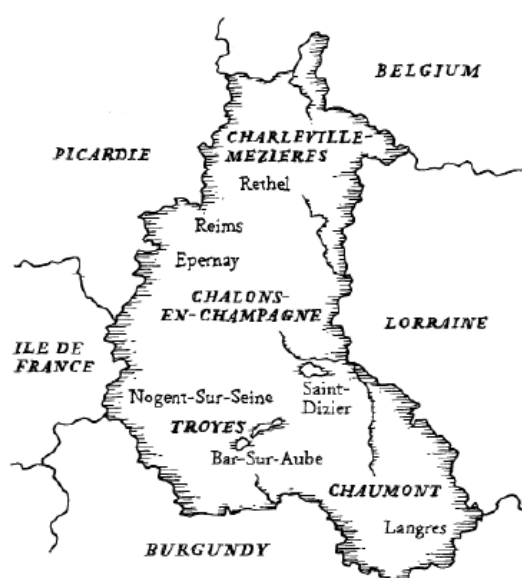

In Napa where red wine is king, George Vare dared to say that white wine could say something too. He was inspired by the idiosyncratic winemakers of Friuli Venezia Giulia: Enzo Pontoni, Giorgio Bensa, Stanko Radikon, and Josko Gravner and surrounded himself with like minded thinkers in Napa: John Kongsgaard, Abe Schoener, and Steve Matthiasson. These two groups of mavericks shared a love of tradition and of experimentation.

The grape of choice for these winemakers in Friuli is ribolla gialla and George Vare fell in love with it so much that he smuggled budwood back from Josko Gravner in 2001 and planted it in his home vineyard. He already had success with another Friulian varietal, pinot grigio, at Luna Vineyards, but ribolla gialla had never been planted in America before. In 2005 he started the Vare brand with Abe Schoener (Scholium Project), as winemaker, and Steve Matthiasson (Matthiasson Wines), as vineyard manager. George wanted to create a wine that he could show his colleagues in Friuli.











He was more than a maverick though. He was a mentor. He identified young winemakers who had something they wanted to say and believed that ribolla gialla was the way to say it. Many of these names Massican, Ryme, Arnot Roberts, Forlorn Hope have been identified as some of the most innovative producers in California. George passed away in 2013. Because of him ribolla gialla is here to stay. It is now a part of UC Davis nursery collection and cuttings from Vare and from the nursery have been used to plant rows in multiple vineyards in Napa and the Russian River Valley including Steve Matthiasson's home vineyard.

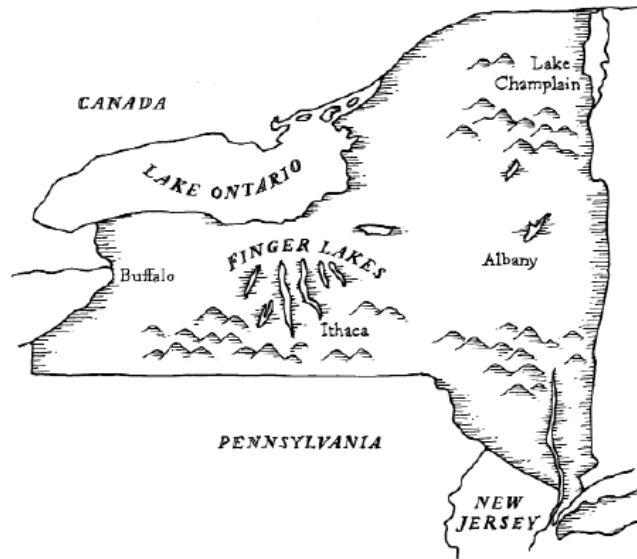

What is the difference between an old vine and a young vine? When a vine is 20 to 25 years old, the amount of grapes it produces begins to decrease, and by the time it is 80 or 85 years old, the crop is small at best. At the same time the vines grow into part of their environment and eco-system. The idea of place in the wine becomes more evident in aromatics, flavor, and structure.





The sad truth is that most growers are paid not by quality of fruit but by quantity. Grapes such as zinfandel, carignan, cinsault, valdiguie, mouvedre, charbono, and others that grow in many of these older vineyards actually fetch less per ton as well. So it makes economic sense to rip up these vineyards and plant pinot noir or to sell them to a developer.

To not sell or plant to another varietal is a risky decision. It is a choice to support culture and history over more economic certainty. These varietals and vines are never going to fetch the same profit as more popular varietals, but they do represent a time before the modernization of the California wine scene.

This section highlights producers who are pushing the wine scene forward by looking back to the generations of farmers who planted and worked the vineyards before them.

Each time we pick up a glass of wine we are seeking something romantic, some connection to our roots. There is no more direct connection to the roots of American winemaking than these historic vineyards and varietals. The wines are fruit forward, but soft. They have structure, acidity, and integrated tannins. And they are disappearing. To retain history we have to support those producers that are looking to preserve it. And the best part of it all is that our part in it is simply to drink delicious wine.
